

IED Counterterrorism Workshop (2 days)
September 14th and 15th
0830-1700 hrs.

Overview

In support of its mission to reduce the risk to the Nation's critical infrastructure, the Office of Infrastructure Protection maintains a catalog of training programs to develop awareness of terrorist threats to critical infrastructure among State, local, and private sector entities and educate participants on strategies for detecting and mitigating these threats. Coordinated with State Homeland Security Officials and training offices, these courses may be requested by State, local, tribal, territorial agencies and critical infrastructure owners and operators through DHS Protective Security Advisors (PSAs).

Workshop Purpose

This awareness level workshop is designed to enhance the knowledge of state/local law enforcement and public/private sector stakeholders by providing exposure to key elements of the improvised explosive device (IED) threat, surveillance detection methods and soft target awareness. The workshop illustrates baseline awareness and prevention actions that reduce vulnerabilities to counter the threat along with collaborating information sharing resources to improve preparedness. This designed approach better enables the owners and operators of critical infrastructure and key resources to deter, prevent, detect, protect against, and respond to terrorist use of explosives in the United States

Workshop Format: The IED Counterterrorism Workshop is presented in seminar style for up to 250 participants. This is a 2 day workshop delivered in 2 eight hour sessions.
